

City Prayer-Walking Guide

"Every place that the sole of your foot will tread upon I have given to you, just as I promised to Moses." - Joshua 1:3

1. Prepare Your Heart

- Begin with worship: "Our Father in heaven, hallowed be Your name" (Matthew 6:9).
- Ask the Holy Spirit to guide your steps and words (John 16:13).
- Put on the armor of God (Ephesians 6:10–18).

2. Pray on Site with Insight

As you walk your streets, pray blessing over:

- Homes & Families "As for me and my house, we will serve the LORD" (Joshua 24:15).
- Schools & Children "All your children shall be taught by the LORD" (Isaiah 54:13).
- Businesses & Workers "May the favor of the Lord our God rest on us" (Psalm 90:17).
- Government & Leaders "Pray...for kings and all who are in high positions" (1 Timothy 2:2).
- Churches & Believers "That they may all be one...so that the world may believe" (John 17:21).

3. Declare God's Word

Speak Scripture over your city:

- **Peace:** "Seek the welfare of the city...and pray to the LORD on its behalf" (Jeremiah 29:7).
- **Revival:** "Will You not revive us again, that Your people may rejoice in You?" (Psalm 85:6).
- **Salvation:** "For the Son of Man came to seek and to save the lost" (Luke 19:10).

4. Listen and Watch


- Ask: "Lord, what are You saying here?"
- Notice people, places, or needs that stir compassion.
- Be ready for divine appointments to listen, encourage, or share the Gospel.

5. Pray in Teams of Two or Three

- Jesus sent them out two by two (Luke 10:1).
- Agree together: "If two of you agree on earth about anything... it will be done" (Matthew 18:19).

6. Close with Thanksgiving

- Thank God for what He is doing and will do (Philippians 4:6).
- Ask for His Kingdom to come in your city (Matthew 6:10).
- Leave every street, person, and place in His hands.
