










CORONAVIRUS PANDEMIC – SPECIAL PRAYER BRIEFING

In response to the developing Coronavirus Pandemic, we are bringing you this very important update with an invitation to join many Christians from around the world as we pray and respond to the situation.

As we face this unprecedented crisis in the nations, we are seeing a massive move toward prayer. The prayer calls I have been on these past few days have been astonishing in the number of participants as well as the passion of those praying.





The biblical response to crisis is a cry for Mercy. He is the merciful God. Let's humble ourselves, turn from our sins and re-consecrate ourselves to God (Joel 2). Let's confess the sins of our nation(s) and cry out to God for mercy (Daniel 9). As we pray in faith, let's believe together that this pandemic will abate, many millions will come to Christ, families will become more prayer devoted, the church will be united, and 2020 will go down in history - not as the year where the nations collapsed - but as the year of historic advance of prayer, evangelism and missions worldwide!

I want to remind us that the LORD sees us! He hears our prayers and the cry of our hearts. He really understands how big this situation can seem to be and yet, He is so GLAD to be with us in the midst of it all. YOU ARE NOT ALONE! He's BIGGER than the current events and He's definitely NOT surprised or "taken off guard" by the recent virus. In fact, this is EXACTLY what He told us to prepare for when His disciples asked Him about the signs of His return!

"And there will be famine, pestilences (ie. diseases), and earthquakes in various places... all these are the beginning of birth pangs (ie. contractions)" (Matthew 24:7-8, NKJV).

How did the all-knowing God want us to feel emotionally and respond both spiritually and practically to these things? Look at verse 6.



"See that you are not troubled; for all these things must come to pass, but the end is not yet" (Matthew 24:6).

We know in the midst of increasing fear and anxiety that God's perfect love casts out fear and he says to us "Do not be anxious about anything, but in everything by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known to God. And the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus" (Philippians 4:6-7).

OUR VISION:

"Compelled by God to seek Christ's glory worldwide for the blessing, healing, and transforming of the nations, International Prayer Connect exists as a coalition of prayer networkers and mobilizers working together to motivate, develop and equip national movements and local churches to fill all nations with prayer for the fulfilment of the Great Commandment and the completion of the Great Commission."



HOW WE OPERATE:

The <u>IPC</u> is not an organization as such. We are a fellowship of people involved in mobilizing prayer throughout the world. We function as an international "network of networks", connecting international, regional, and national prayer ministries and networks. We also arrange or support special prayer initiatives that bring prayer leaders together from time to time to pray for matters of regional and global concern to the Body of Christ. Regional prayer summits have been arranged or supported by the IPC in most regions of the world as well as international prayer initiatives for the United Nations, Hollywood, and other issues.

The IPC is led by an international leadership team, now called the International Prayer Council, is composed of twenty leaders who coordinate regional prayer networks or international prayer initiatives of various kinds. We seek to be catalysts and connectors within the global prayer movement towards the fulfilment of Habakkuk 2:14- that "the earth will be filled with the knowledge of the glory of the Lord as the waters cover the sea."

We do not have an official membership but connect with individuals and networks through IPC Connections, a periodical newsletter distributed via e-mail to give prayer information to interested people. Please share this newsletter with prayer coordinators, prayer network leaders, and others who have an interest in the global prayer movement so that they can be informed about different prayer initiatives, existing prayer networks, and how to participate in them.
