How to Pray for Hotspots

For more than 20 years, it has been my privilege to facilitate interdenominational prayer initiatives in many of the hard places of the earth where there is war and intense human suffering, hopeless and impossible situations. As our ministry teams joined local brothers and sisters in Christ in humbling ourselves, getting right with the Lord and one another in times of moving reconciliation and repentance, over and over again we witnessed God's gracious hand coming in to bring about deliverance, with marvelous breakthroughs that resulted in peace agreements, governments of national unity and spiritual revival among ministry leaders. It was not because we were some great prayer gurus at all. Instead, in childlike dependence, along with the local ministry leaders, we sought to align ourselves under His direction as the only one who could really solve such gargantuan difficulties.

A team of four of us are planning to go into Iraq and Syria later this month for two prayer initiatives for these war-torn nations. Please pray for us and for the local brothers and sisters as we gather to seek His breakthrough.

Here are some simple lessons or principles that may be helpful in praying for the hot spots in your region:

- 1. God can turn things around through united and authoritative prayer to bring healing and reconciliation in the world's trouble spots.
- 2. Prayer initiatives should be interdenominational, if not international, efforts that bring many believers into heart agreement as Jesus encouraged in Matthew 18:18-20.
- 3. Dependence on God and His direction is essential in undertaking such an initiative. Ask for and expect His guidance step by step through the whole process.
- 4. In order to experience the kind of faith-filled, united praying that brings breakthrough and transformation, the relationships of those praying first need to be reconciled.
- 5. Believers need to identify with and confess the sins of their own ethnic groups or political factions in a conflict, asking God and those from the opposing groups for forgiveness.
- 6. Pray transconfessionally. Include the whole of Christ's Church and try to draw as many denominations and traditions as possible into your prayer effort. Be sensitive to the particular style of others, even if it seems foreign to your own. Strive for unity in diversity.

- 7. Pray holistically. Listen to the Spirit of God and pray about any issues He begins to surface during the sharing and prayer times. Ask for peace, healing and restoration of communities, tribes and nations caught up in the conflict.
- 8. Gather and disseminate information. Learn about the situation you are praying for because in the realm of prayer you get what you specifically ask for. Also share what you learn with prayer networks and intercessors who can pray in support.
- Expect God's illumination as you proceed. As we listen and pray, we can count on the Lord to put His finger on the main issues that are hindering His peace. Be open to prophetic impressions, words or images that the Spirit sometimes gives spontaneously to participants (I Corinthians 14:26 f).
- 10. Engage for the long term. Sometimes there are "suddenlies" that happen, but generally deep transformation does not happen overnight. Persevering prayer is usually needed over weeks and months, sometimes years, for real and substantial impact.

Take time to observe and discern during the initiative and to keep track of what happens during it and afterwards. How has God answered? Write down your insights and reflections, then share them with others to encourage their faith and continued prayer.

Kingdom Kemels: The Prayer Life of a Movement Catalyst

Every church planting movement (CPM) and discipleship multiplication movement is also fundamentally a prayer movement. Fervently calling upon God in faith is foundational to the miraculous move of God's Spirit. Of course, CPMs do not occur only through prayer; reproducing evangelism, discipleship, church planting and leadership development are essential. But without a move of the Spirit, and thrusting ourselves upon Him in prayer, these latter elements are mere mechanics.

What does the prayer life of men and women in the center of movements look like? Let me describe common characteristics, and especially take you in for a closer look at the prayer life of Ying and Grace Kai who were for many years used by God in catalyzing a church planting movement in Asia - over 1.7 million baptisms and 158,000 new churches.

Person not just principles, man not just methods

CPM methodologies and processes are essential in helping us raise our ministry sails to catch the wind of the Spirit and move as He is moving. However, the closer we look at CPMs, the more obvious it becomes that God uses men not simply methods, persons not just principles or programs.

A colleague who tracks CPMs around the world traveled with Ying Kai for six days watching him interact with people. Listen to his observation: The person, Ying, is successful, not the program. The man is the key to the results, not the method that is being used. We had numerous comments during the week indicating that his particular lessons were nothing special What did become evident is that the person God uses, Ying, exemplifies, models and lives out what it is he is teaching.[1]

In other words, the quality of spiritual integrity and seeking God's leading at every juncture were more important than the reproducible methods he was

using successfully. The Spirit was empowering the reproducible processes to produce life. We cannot say that if you are more spiritually mature, you will have a greater movement of God. What we can is that no movement will occur if we are not spiritually in-tune people.

Time in prayer daily

This begins in seeking God deeply in prayer. Fervent, faith-filled intercession is the spiritual climate of every movement. Since a movement is, by definition, a move God God's Spirit, we must be seech the Father to bring His kingdom as Jesus taught us in the model prayer.

Movement catalysts each have different patterns for their daily prayer life. But Ying and Grace's prayer life serves as a helpful model. Again listen to my colleague's observations from that six-day trip:

When various participants asked Ying further about the practicality of always praying in advance [before every ministry encounter], he described his DAILY practice of rising early and often praying one to two hours for his ministry every single day. He then pulled up his pants legs and showed two calloused knees to the group and indicated that those he trains [his main leaders], he insists must become persons of prayer, and he communicates to them that it would be best if they pray at least two hours every morning prior to going out to begin their other ministries.

Ying and Grace rise early each day to pray through every name of every person they will encounter that day. Ying trains his trainers that their witnessing will have much more effect if they pray for God to open the hearts of the lost before they themselves open their mouths.

It is not coincidental that the breakthrough for a CPM in our own work in East Asia came when our local team and global partners seriously began to humble ourselves in intercession through weekly prayer and fasting.

Led by the Spirit

Starting the day in prayer is just the prelude to walking in the Spirit throughout the day, following His promptings. How easy it is for us to begin the day in prayer and the Word, asking to be filled with the Spirit, only to walk in our own leading when we get off our knees and into the streets! Abiding in Christ (John 15) is much more than a quiet time. Rather it is a posture of reliance upon God, following the leading of His Spirit. It is praying without ceasing (1 Thes. 5:17) - staying in connection with the Father. It is how Jesus lived His life:

"Truly, truly, I say to you, the Son can do nothing of his own accord, but only what he sees the Father doing. For whatever the Father does, that the Son does likewise." John 5:19 (ESV)

In their days while working in East Asia, there was a remarkable focus, even "narrowness", to what Ying and Grace were about. Daily they tried to do three things well: 1) pray, 2) witness, 3) train. Everything else took a back seat. They prayed before they left their home and then prayed throughout the day. If they met lost people, they witnessed to them. If they led them to faith, or met an existing believer, they offered to train them. Prayer guided each encounter.

Prayer with the lost, prayer with the saved, prayer on every occasion A common factor in every CPM is that God is demonstrating Himself in miraculous ways. This is often in direct response to disciples praying aloud

to the Provider for the needs of lost people in their presence. It is reminiscent of Jesus' instructions to the 70 disciples He sent out:

"Heal the sick in it and say to them, 'The kingdom of God has come near to you." Luke 10:9 (ESV)

Similar things are occurring in various gatherings of faith-filled believers, who like the Acts church, are amazed at the wonders of God:

And awe came upon every soul, and many wonders and signs were being done through the apostles. Acts 2:43 (ESV)

In CPMs believers are calling out for God to act as He has always acted in His Word and then trusting Him for results. This can be a bit challenging for many of us who are concerned that God's reputation is on the line when we pray in this manner. But listen to this insight:

When Ying was asked about praying for others, he indicated that he always prays for others when asked. When the subject of healings and such came up, he indicated that he would ask God in advance what to pray for people, and he would pray what God communicated to him was God's intention for that situation. Ying has no reluctance whatsoever in following this pattern to pray for healing, pray for deliverance, pray for freedom from sinful habits, pray for the restoration of relationships, and pray for a myriad of other results. It is because he always prays first to ask God what to pray that he has no reluctance to publicly or privately "put God on the spot" to pray for dramatic results.

Four Areas to Pray Daily

Let's zero in on four areas that Ying and Grace pray for daily, and teach to all their trainers, so that they may walk in the power of the Spirit.

1. Jesus' blood to protect us

Just as Jesus taught us in the model prayer to beseech the Father to "protect us from the evil one" (Matt. 6:13), so also Ying and Grace pray this daily. As the enemy sets his sights on the faithful, we must cry out to God for His protection from these fiery darts. The battle is real but the blood of Jesus conquers.

It was interesting to me how many times in teaching a variety of subjects Ying referred to the blood of Christ. He referred to his daily practice, during personal devotions requesting Jesus to cover him with the blood of Christ as a protection against various obstructions and intrusions from the evil one. He often referred to praying that the blood of Christ would cover groups he is training and protect them from the evil one's attacks. He often referred to the blood of Christ when he presented an evangelistic message and dealt with the cross. He has memorized a number of scriptures that deal with the blood of Christ and frequently quotes them in his teaching and his personal interaction with others. It struck me how infrequently I pray for the protection of the blood of Christ, or make reference to the blood of Christ in my witnessing or daily conversations.

- 2. Putting on the whole armor of God in prayer piece by piece We are commanded in Ephesians 6:10-20 to put on the whole armor of God for the spiritual battle. One way that Ying and Grace do this, and train others to do it, is to put on each piece one at a time in prayer. They make a conscious effort to go through the entire list and, in faith, dress themselves in spiritual armor.
- 3. Ask for whatever gift you need in order to serve God Ying frequently exhorts his trainers to ask the Holy Spirit to give them whatever gifts they need to serve God. Don't think spiritual gifts, as we commonly think, but rather, any ability they need. If a trainer needs the gift

of speaking better, giving more generously or serving more lovingly, then he is encouraged to ask God for this ability, and then to take active steps to learn how to do that. Our Father is ready to give good gifts to His children. He wants us to ask (Matt. 7:11).

4. Give thanks in and for everything

One of the greatest acts of faith is to give God thinks not only in every circumstance (1 Thes. 5:18), but for every circumstance. But Paul makes it clear that this is a fruit of being filled with the Spirit (Eph. 5:20). Ying and Grace encourage their trainers to thank and praise God for all things. It if often in thanking God for the difficult things, that they actually see spiritual breakthrough.

Ying Kai credits God freeing him from a life-long anger problem to giving thanks for this problem:

For me it was very strange. I did not really believe yet, but I prayed to God. "God, I know it's very strange but I'll try to give thanks to you because You created me. My attitude has been bad and I always lose my temper but I give thanks to you because I belong to you. I know in myself I cannot change or heal myself so I pray to you. Today let me know that I am nothing; only You can help me." I tried to just give thanks to the Lord and praise him. So I praised and sang and praised and sang. Every day I did this.

One day my wife told me to come and look at the calendar. Every day since we were married she had marked each day when I lost my temper. Some days it was three times, some days five times. Then she said, "How many days do you think it has been since you lost your temper and fought with me? Six months!"

I had prayed for 26 years and many other people prayed for me. I asked, asked but now I only sang to the Lord and praised the Lord. God changed my mind; He changed my attitude. So when you praise the Lord he'll change everything. Grace said, "When you praise the Lord, that means you honor God and his power."[1]


Prayer is spiritual climate of every movement of God. The personal prayer life of each movement catalyst is a precious treasure to the Father. It is this interaction with God that sets the foundation for a movement:

My bottom line summation is that it is not the tools that are the key. It is the modeling, holy life, intense focus on heaven, hell, judgment, and the need for salvation which are some of the keys to Ying's effectiveness. All this is to say that those who "catch his spirit" and model it in front of new believers are more likely to see the same type of results than those who came, copied the lessons, and plan to go back and just repeat the methodology.

Situation In North Korea

Over the past two months we have been reporting on the outbreak of foot and mouth disease among North Korean livestock. This is a very serious disease that can devastate the nations supply of pigs, cattle, goats and other cloven-hoofed animals. The latest reports are that it continues in the North but there is no clear knowledge of the extent. Soon after the first cases occurred, South Korea offered help in eradication and prevention but the North has not responded. South Korea sustained a devastating outbreak several years ago and works very hard to prevent more.

In addition to the threat to the meat supply there is growing concern over the food supply in general.

Except for those who have the special privilege of living in Pyongyang, people throughout the country are struggling. The provision of rice and other staples through the



Public Distribution System has ceased. Last year, many people received rations from the special stores set aside for the military--which were often moldy and full of bugs--but even that is not being provided this year resulting in a great deal of dissatisfaction. At the same time, Choco-pies and Ramen noodles provided through South Korean companies at the Kaesong Industrial Park are the basis for a whole separate economy.

Meanwhile, the government's efforts to assure agricultural bounty through the use of the military continues to backfire breeding corruption and hardship and the rise of a new class conflict. Additionally, soldiers being detailed to important construction projects are taking the food they need from the general populace.

Of course, food is not the only problem the people face as efforts to stem defection increase. More families face internal exile because of family members who have crossed illegally into China while those who do so legally are under pressure to report on any defectors that they hear about. North Korea is also sending teams of security agents into China to search out and arrest North Koreans who have escaped into the country.

An interesting development on the political front is the apparent removal from power of Kim Jong Un's aunt, Kim Kyung-Hui, wife of executed former number-two-man, Jang Son Thaek by eliminating her from all records. A video that had included her has just been re-released with her edited out of it.

Kim Jong Un has been quite active lately in carrying out inspections around the country. May 5th is Children's Day in South Korea and May 8th is Parents' Day. As we think about these holidays, it is good to think about the children and families of North Korea as well as the idolization of the leader as a father for all the people.



Billion Souls Revival Prayer Call 2015

The Billion Souls Revival Prayer Call 2015 is a period of 40 days of prayer,

fasting and repentance beginning on International Day of Repentance (Yom Kippur) Tuesday sundown 22 September, 2015 and continues to sundown Sunday 1 November, 2015.

Five Point Prayer Plan

1. Pray for a worldwide outpouring of the Holy Spirit for renewal for the church and revival and transformation for the nations of the world. Acts 2:1-47



- 2. Pray for a revival of a new evangelisation so that a billion people from outside the church will find faith in Jesus Christ as their Lord and Saviour. John 3:16
- 3. Pray for a revival of Sexual Purity and renewal of marriage and family to help the children of the world. 1 Thessalonians 4: 3-7
- 4. Pray for a revival of the sanctity of life and a turning of the tide of abortion in the nations of the world. Proverbs 24:11-12
- 5. Pray for a multiplication of prayer, praise and worship to God across the world as never before, to bring great glory to God. Psalm 107:21-22

Strategy

Initially we want to canvass the idea with international prayer leaders and key church leaders and finalise a five point prayer plan that will be acceptable to a broad range of believers within the various denominations, church communities, prayer ministries and nations...The previous Billion Souls Revival Prayer Call in 2013 received wide support from international and national prayer leaders. We are confident, based on past experience, that this level of support would be multiplied greatly.

The real challenge lies in gaining support from world leaders in the Catholic, Protestant, Pentecostal, Orthodox and Oriental Orthodox traditions...It is important to embrace as many cultures and denominations as possible for this call to prayer. For the Billion Souls Revival Prayer Call 2015 to work we must look for what will unite us, as opposed to what will divide us, as the key to the success of this prayer project is unity. Our call to prayer needs to be short and simple and to the point as well as being Biblical.

We are not expecting everyone who participates in the Billion Souls Revival Prayer Call to conduct a full fast for 40 days but people may miss one meal per day, or fast one day per week or a Daniel Fast (Vegan) for the 40 day period. What we are expecting is that everyone who participates will pray through the 5 Point Prayer Plan each day and engage in some level of fasting as decided by that individual. It is our goal also that individual churches could either have daily or weekly prayer meetings to take part in this 40 day period of prayer and fasting. We greatly value your input, thoughts and prayers at this time.



Escalating Violence further threatens South Sudan



The January ceasefire agreement between warring factions has been a dismal failure. Violence of the last four months has affected every aspect of the world's youngest nation. It has:

- Displaced more than one million people
- Prevented farmers from planting crops
- Devastated the oil production, a major portion of the government's revenue
- Disrupted education
- Created emotional and psychological trauma, especially for women and children.

Looming large now is the threat of starvation. A UN aid worker, Toby Lanzar warns that South Sudan is now on a par with Syria as 1/3 of the population is at severe risk of starvation. "If we miss the planting season, there will be a catastrophic decline in food security," he reports. Crops must be planted before the end of May.

Caught in the middle of the violence are the children. UNICEF spokeswoman Doune Porter says, "To be able to introduce some kind of normality, some kind of routine by going to school is very important." More than 170 temporary school spaces have been set up.

The battle is a spiritual one. As Christians we must enter the spiritual battle and pray on behalf of those suffering who are precious to God.

Let's Pray:

- The displaced children to have safe and stable living conditions and continuity of education (The Bible, Matthew 19:14).
- Farmer to be protected from harm and upheaval as they plant crops before the end of May (The Bible, Jeremiah 5:24).
- Political figures and parties to recognize that their differences are devastating the country. Pray that they will confess their sins and repent of their hunger for power. (The Bible, 2 Chronicles 7:14).

Continue to Pray for Afghanistan

Afghans went to the polls last month and voted in record numbers in a reasonably peaceful atmosphere for which we give thanks to the Lord. The prayer movement there was also energized by a recent prayer initiative that was jointly led by a local humanitarian organization and the IPC. Thank God also that a planned attack by the Taliban against the whole international Christian community while we were praying was foiled, and the five suicide attackers either blew themselves up or were killed in a fire fight with security guards and the Afghan special forces.



Unfortunately, one week ago, there was an attack on the hospital run by the organization Christian CURE in Kabul.. Three Christian doctors from the USA were killed and one of their wives was injured and is in critical condition. The attacker was a security guard at the hospital and it is not clear yet whether he was officially from the police or a Taliban. We mourn for the loss of our brothers and pray for the

sister who was wounded as well as for the Christian community and NGOs that are working in the country.

International organizations have been warned of possible further attacks on foreign NGOs. Please pray for the relatives of those that have been killed and our sister that was injured to be restored again. Also the Christian Foreign Community in Kabul city has been hit quite badly and they need prayer, especially the staff of the CURE hospital.

Continue also to pray for the overthrow and dissolution of the Taliban as a political and military movement and for the runoff election to determine the new president of the nation. May he be the man of God's choosing and favor for this time!

The country continues to suffer economically. Tourism, a major contributor in the Egyptian economy, is down. Its revenues slid 66% in the first half of fiscal year 2013/2014, according to Ministry of Finance. A reassuring thing is that the majority of Egyptians today are standing up for equal rights for all. That includes the Christians, who should not be considered secondclass citizens. For the first time in the history of modern Egypt, the President visited the Coptic Orthodox Pope and congratulated him for Christmas.
