


Exercising the Authority Given to Us

Russia Military Maneuvers Signal Possible Full-Scale Invasion of Ukraine

Radio Free Europe reports Russian military forces are carrying out "logistical exercises" in and around the Crimean Peninsula, the Ukrainian Black Sea region that Russia annexed in 2014. The land and naval forces participating in the "exercises" have increased tensions



in the wake of Moscow's accusations earlier this month that Ukraine was plotting "sabotage" attacks in Crimea. Ukrainian President Petro Poroshenko on August 17 warned that he does not rule out "a full-scale Russian invasion" and said that if the situation in the east and around Crimea continues to deteriorate, "we will have to impose martial law and order mobilization." **Note**: Moscow is likely making the calculation that now is the time to invade because they don't expect Obama will respond with more than words and without American leadership NATO is feckless and Ukraine becomes another Russian war trophy.

It is not an unusual thing to hear athletes giving praise to God when things go well. Many professionals are now in the habit of pointing up after they make a good play. A wide receiver out runs a group of



defenders, and as they cross the goal line, he points to the sky.

But would it not be weird if, then in like manner so did the defenders? People would have been shocked if Cam Newton had done a post-game interview after the Super Bowl, in which he gave Christ the glory for coming in second

But the equivalent happened last night in Rio, and it was awesome. Town Hall reports

A golden moment took place alongside the Rio Olympic diving boards Monday night. The Chinese team of Chen Aisen and Lin Yue may have taken first place, but U.S. divers David Boudia and Steele Johnson stole the spotlight in their NBC interview by giving all the glory to God after their silver medal-winning performance.

But it is not the medal for which Boudia was giving praise. No, he was giving praise for the fact that he could stand on that international stage with the full assurance that his identity and worth was not found in his sport or accomplishments. He said that his identity was found in Christ. His teammate quickly restated the reason they could compete without fear. It was that they found their worth in Christ and not the event or its outcome. They find their worth in Christ and not in themselves or their accomplishments.

The IPC is led by an international leadership team, now called the International Prayer Council, is composed of twenty leaders who coordinate regional prayer networks or international prayer initiatives of various kinds. We seek to be catalysts and connectors within the global prayer movement towards the fulfillment of Habakkuk 2:14- that "the earth will be filled with the knowledge of the glory of the Lord as the waters cover the sea."

We do not have an official membership but connect with individuals and networks through *IPC Connections*, a periodical newsletter distributed via e-mail to give prayer information to interested people.
